 - 31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander

be put away from you, along with all malice.

32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other,

just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

- Colossians 3:12, 13
 - 12 So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved,

<u>put on</u> a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;

- 13 **bearing with one another,** and **forgiving each other**, whoever has a complaint against anyone; <u>just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.</u>

 - Genesis 37

'... His brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers;

and so they hated him and could not speak to him on friendly terms.' (v.3, 4)

"...they hated him even more for his dreams and for his words." (v.8)

'When they saw him from a distance and before he came close to them,

they plotted against him to put him to death.' (v.18)

AND RETURN WITH BENJAMIN (v.18-25)

 - -THE BROTHERS RETURN TO EGYPT WITH BENJAMIN
 - -JOSEPH SERVES HIS BROTHERS A FEAST AT HIS OWN HOUSE (v.30, 32-34)
- Genesis 44
 - -JOSEPH SENDS HIS BROTHERS AWAY WITH SACKS OF GRAIN
 SILVER CUP PLANTED IN BENJAMIN'S
- Genesis 45
 - -JOSEPH CAN'T CONTAIN HIMSELF ANY LONGER (v.1-5; 14, 15)
- Genesis 50:15-21
